The fund will cover the cost of providing, planting and initial maintenance of the trees, on an agreement that the new woodland is kept for carbon fixing. The landowner even gets to keep any Woodland Carbon Credits.

As well as carbon capture and to helping to reduce the effect of climate change, the new woodlands will have other positive impacts such as improving and increasing;
