**TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC
B4156 LOW STREET, CHESLYN HAY**

NOTICE is hereby given that the Staffordshire County Council on 2 August 2022 made an Order the effect of which will be to prohibit any vehicle from proceeding in that length of B4156 Low Street in Cheslyn Hay from its junction with B4156 High Street to outside property number 141 unless the vehicle is being used in connection with the works; or unless the vehicle requires access to premises on the length of road or is being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes. Access for pedestrians and cyclists will be available.

An alternative route for traffic is available via B4156 Low Street, B4156 High Street, B4156 Wolverhampton Road, Saredon Road, A460 Lodge Lane, Saredon Road, B4156 Wolverhampton Road. For more information, visit: <https://one.network/?tm=128682726>.

The order will come into operation on 8 August 2022 and the said works will commence on or as near as practicable to that date. It is anticipated that the works will be completed by 12 August 2022.

The Order will remain in force for a period of 18 months, or until the South Staffordshire Water works to repair valve, which it is proposed to carry out on or near the road have been completed, whichever is the earlier.
